

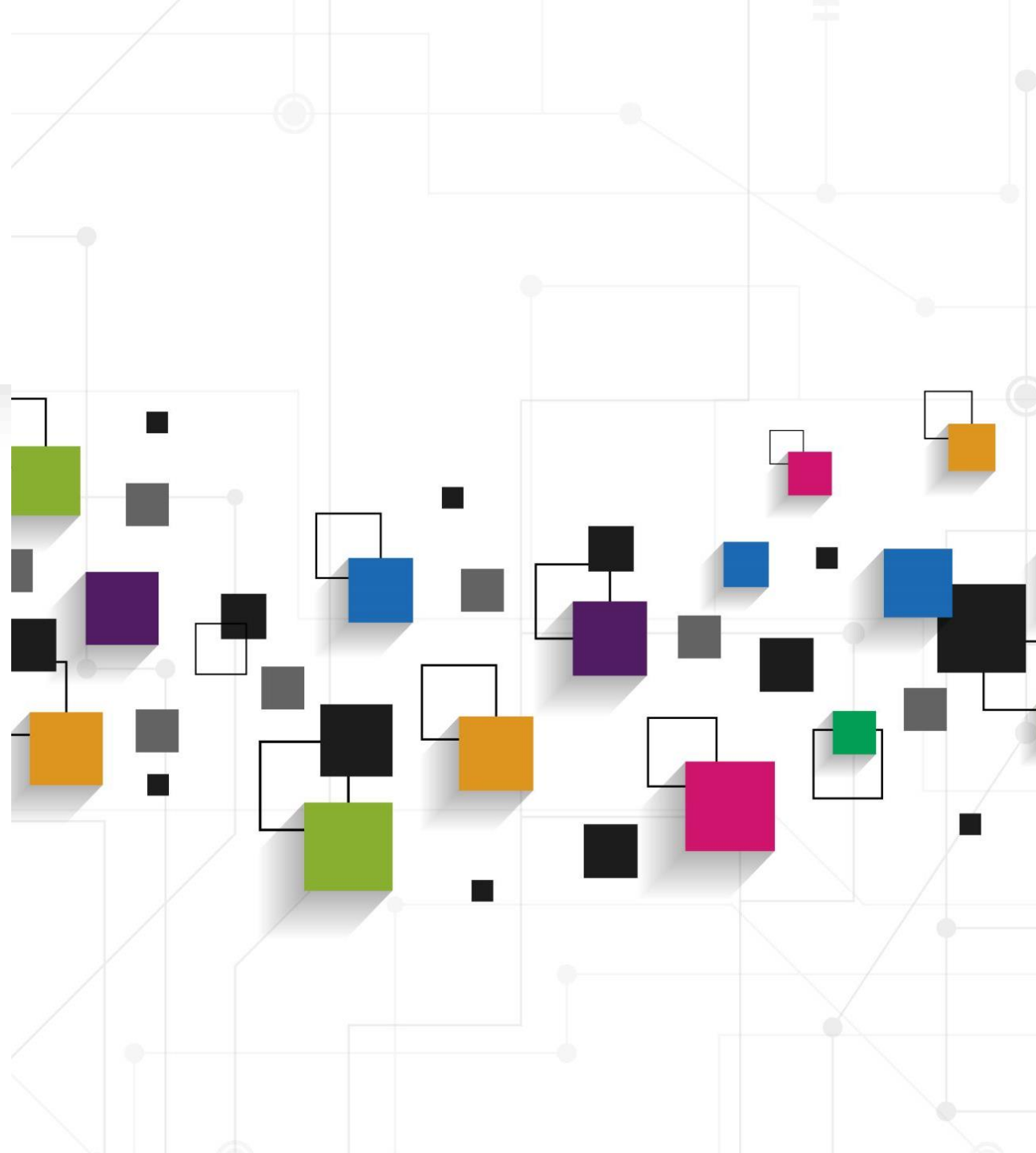

- Android 15's performance can vary depending on the device, with high-end smartphones offering the best experience



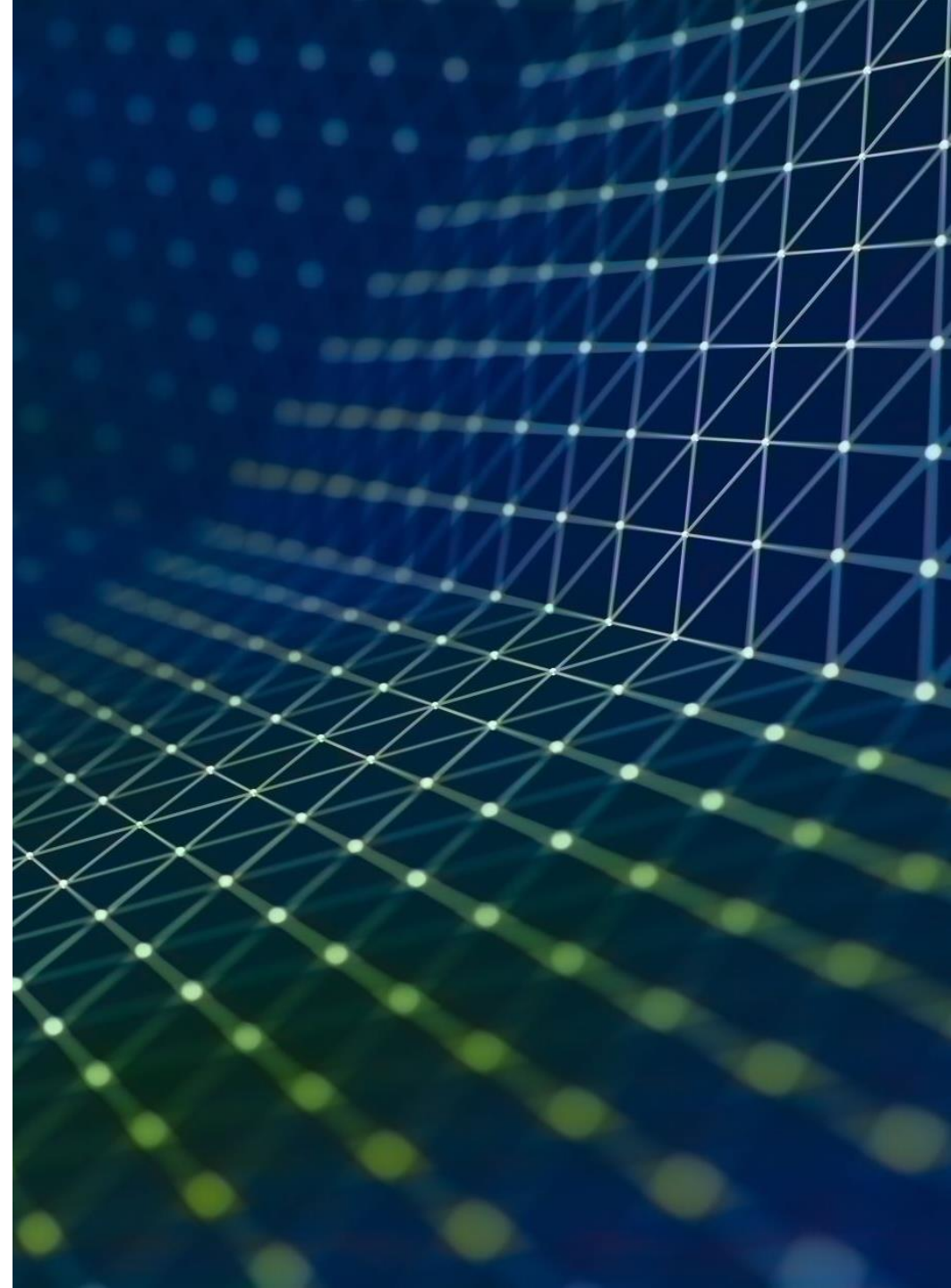


## Multitasking and Productivity

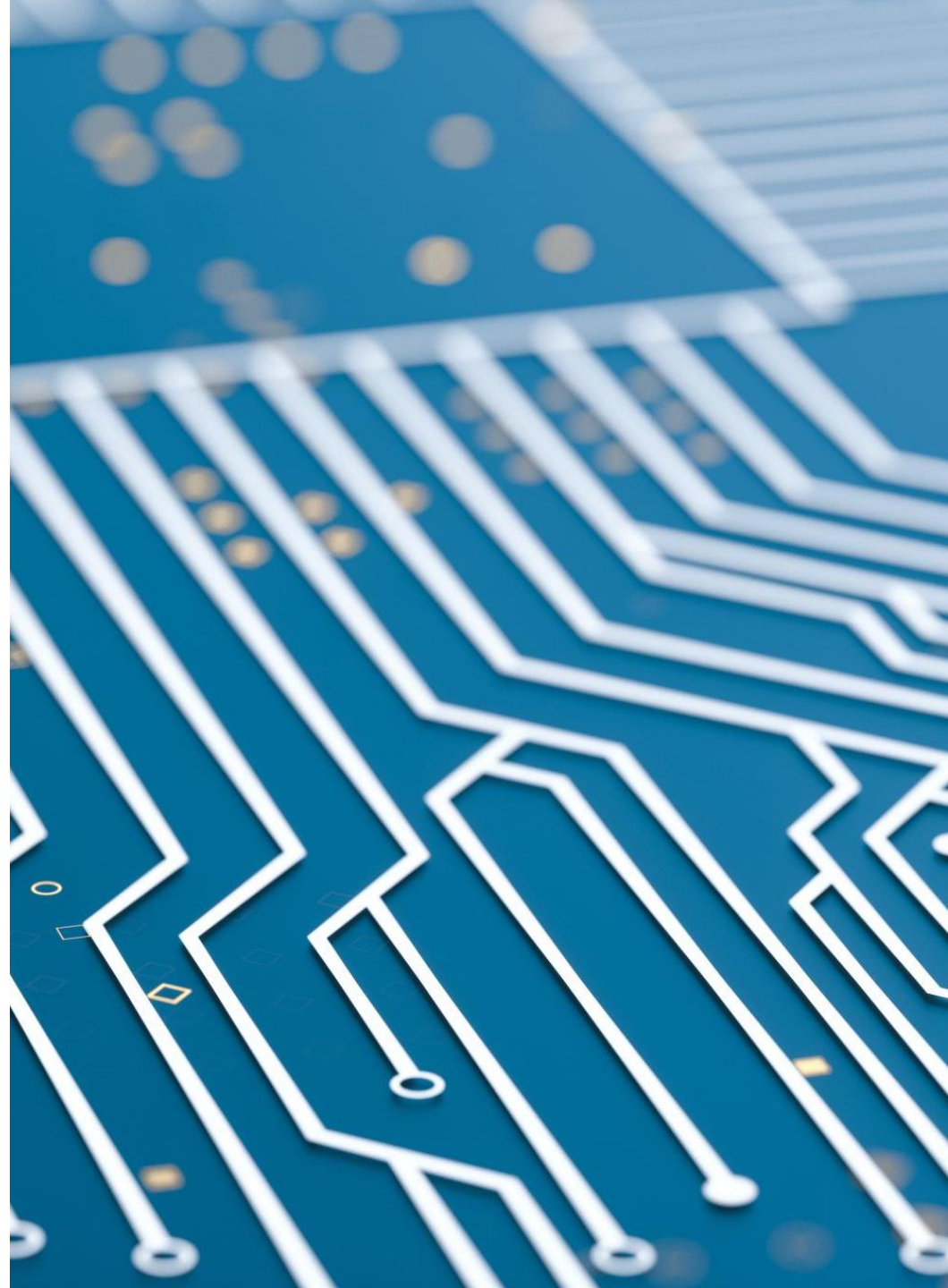
Android 15 excels in multitasking capabilities: It offers features like split-screen, picture-in-picture, and multiple windows<sup>1</sup>

The new App Pairs feature allows users to save and launch two apps together, enhancing productivity on tablets and foldable

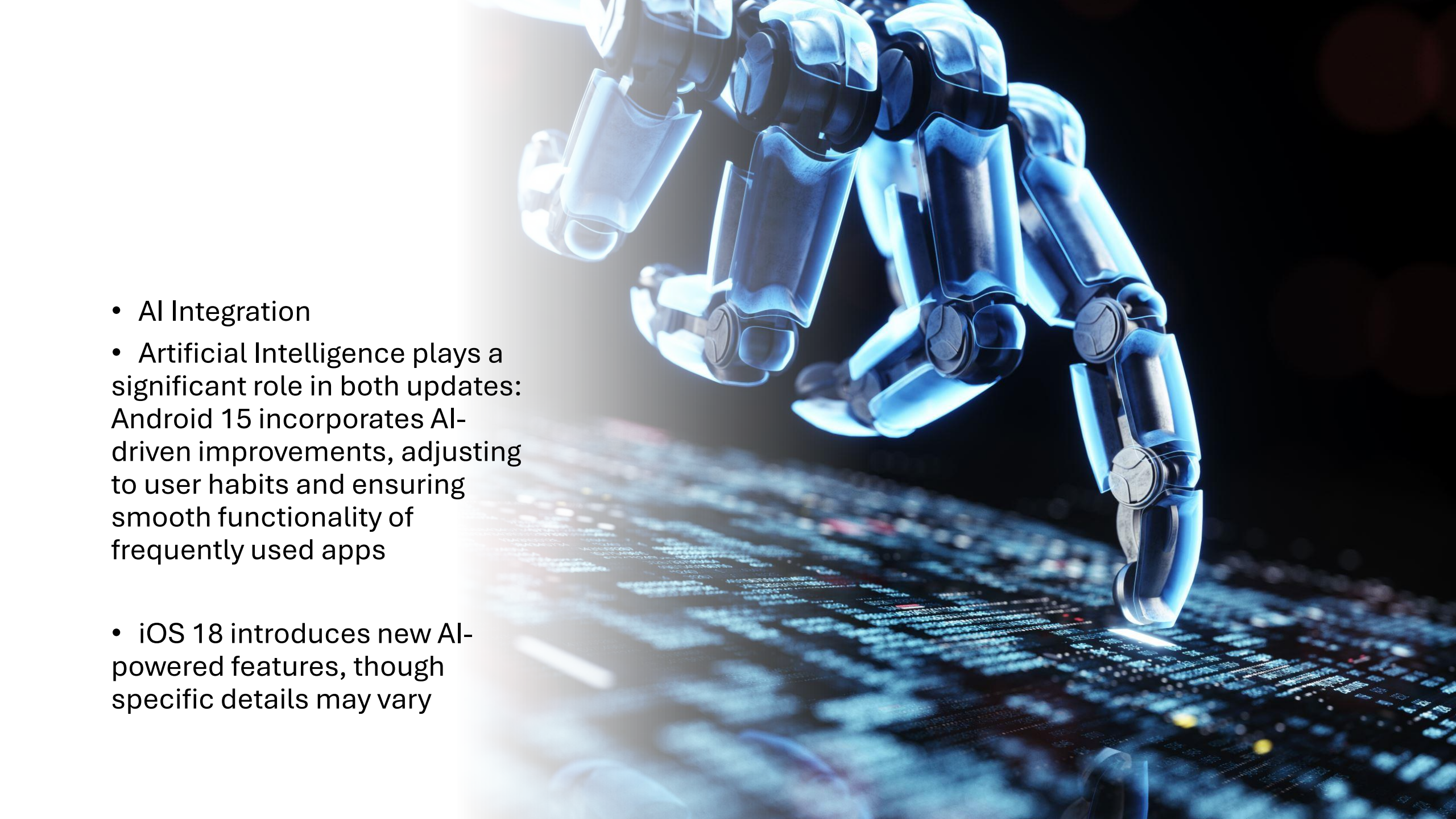
iOS 18 has improved its multitasking, especially on iPads, but still lacks some of Android's advanced features

- iOS 18 is known for its enhanced security and tightly integrated hardware and software





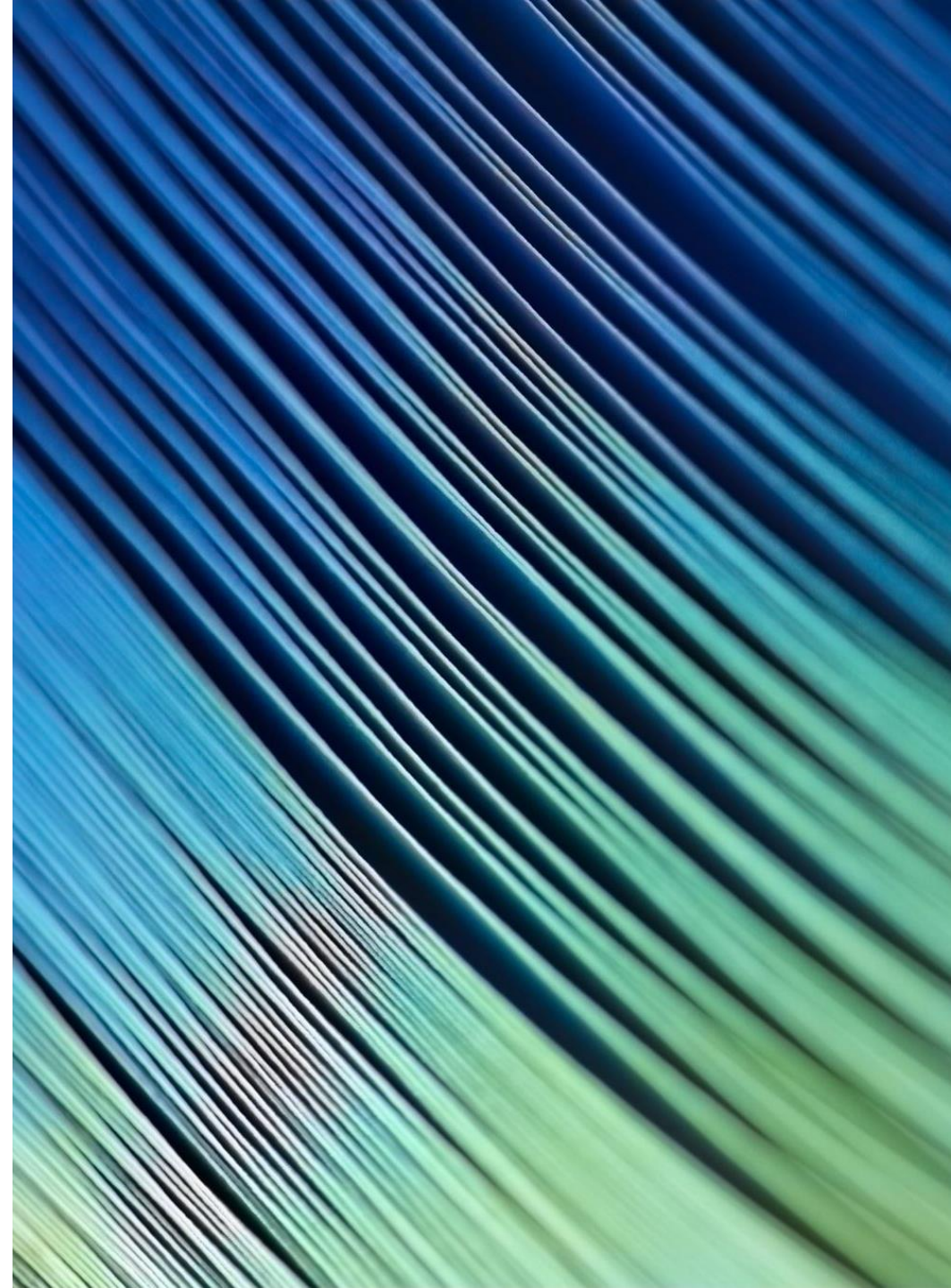

- iOS 18 provides smooth gaming with ProMotion 2.0 and high-quality graphics, but restricts game access to the App Store

Android 15 is available across various price points and device types

iOS 18 is limited to Apple's higher-end devices, which are generally more expensive
